### After School Activity

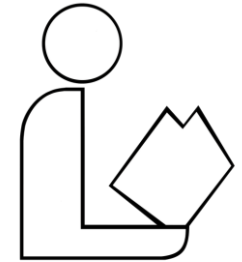
A fun filled activity for children ages 6 to 11. Come and explore the universe of STEAM and develop your creativity during our after school activity.
